

1. This solicitation cycle will include the project code 2022 - Manualized Cognitive Behavioral Group on some of the contracts. Currently, the P.O.'s in the northern part of our district do these groups Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT) in-house. In the future, if our numbers warrant it, it is anticipated the vendor will be asked to run these groups or at least assist the PO's in the facilitation of the group. Some of the contracts list 2020 – Drug group and 2022 - Manualized CBT group. The rate should include course materials for a the Manualized CBT program. It is not likely most of the areas will have enough members for both of these groups therefore, it is anticipated either/or will be used.
2. Currently, we do not have vendors use NIDT's (instant testcups) but we anticipate using them in the future. Therefore, the EMQ's listed in the request for proposals under 1010 and 1011 project codes would be for one or the other, not a combined amount.
3. I received 3 RFP's (request for proposals) in the mail, do I need to submit all of them or can I bid on only one or two? Each RFP stands alone for each contract being solicited. You only need to submit a proposal for those RFP's for which you are interested.
4. Is there a laboratory in place for urine testing? Yes, the vendor takes the sample using the lab slips and supplies provided by the probation office and sends it to the designated lab.
5. The Service Contract Act of 1965, as amended, is part of the RFP for substance abuse treatment services and must be included in any solicitation for urine collection services. This Department of Labor Wage determination form is included in Section J of the contract.
6. Can you please provide clarity: Do you have a list you can provide of the Completed training for the specific manualized CBT program. Do you want the specific curriculum the facilitators use?

The proposal must identify a trained facilitator in a manualized cognitive behavioral program. They should have some sort of certificate of completion. The trained facilitator must have successfully completed the training for the specific manualized CBT program proposed. Some examples of this type of group are : Moral Reconciliation Therapy (which our district has been using in some areas for quite some time), Thinking for a Change, Problem Solving Skills in Action, Choices and Changes, and The Change Companies. Make sure the price proposal includes the course materials. . This information is included on page C-27 of the RFP.

7. E.2- Clause B-5 Clauses Incorp by Reference (SEP 2010)

Can I type?: Vendor Adheres to clause... etc? Is that acceptable?

According to the letter sent with the RFP, Section E does not need to be responded to. This section is informing the vendor that the full language of these clauses is available if requested.

8. Community Recovery Resources currently provides services in Grass Valley/Nevada City area.
9. If you cannot find a staff member certified in Manualized CBT, is it better to submit the proposal even though technically it will be unacceptable; or should we just not submit the proposal at all?

You are required to submit with the proposal (L-11) which is the Offeror's Certification of Compliance Statement. This Statement indicates you can perform all requirements stated in Sections C, E, F and G of the RFP.

10. What are the current prices for 1010,2010,2020, and 6010 for contract #0972-2014-03 (Yuba-Sutter)?

11. May telepsychiatry using video conferencing be used for psychiatric evaluation and report and med management ?

Here is the response from Washington:

While we are exploring the use of telephone-based or video-based services, we are not to the point of approving them at this point. In addition to the programmatic elements to be considered, there are procurement and accounting issues related to the purchase of services versus goods. For example, the requirement for sign-in and sign-out logs to accompany invoices. There also could be licensure and efficacy issues related to the use of these technologies for the provision of services to be considered.
