RE: QUESTIONS & ANSWERS FY-2026 Bidder's Conference

The purpose of this posting is to answer questions received, regarding **Fiscal Year 2026 Solicitations** by the Eastern District of California. Questions can be submitted through Wednesday, July 16, 2025. The following are the questions received at the Bidder's Conference held on Wednesday, July 9, 2025.

- **Question:** How do bidders know to estimate for the unknown clients and how are the estimated monthly quantities figured?
- Answer: We base the EMQs on a year of service and have a system to pull the estimated quantities. As for services that indicate unknown on Section B, this is because this cost will be an actual cost. For example, if we ask a vendor to purchase bus passes, you cannot provide that cost at the time of proposal, so it is an unknown cost. We will pay the actual cost when purchased.
- **Question:** Will we be able to sign the proposal/bid electronically?
- **Answer:** Yes, we accept electronic signatures.
- **Question:** Are all the documents required provided and are the forms fillable
- <u>Answer:</u> Yes, all required documents except required monitoring reports for new bidders, are provided in the RFP. Unfortunately, the forms are not fillable.
