The purpose of this letter is to answer questions received, regarding solicitations issued by the Eastern District of California, for Fiscal Year 2021:

Question: Can you please provide more clarity regarding Section B-Supplies or Services and Offeror's Prices of RFP No. 0972-21-12SM? Specifically, regarding residential services?

Answer: RFP No. 0972-21-12SM (Madera and Merced Counties) is a solicitation for outpatient substance abuse and mental health treatment. RFP No. 0972-21-14SR (Fresno County) is a solicitation for residential substance abuse treatment.

Question: I've thoroughly reviewed RFP 0972-21-12SM, and it doesn't appear that any written narrative is required for this application. Can you please confirm whether or not a written narrative describing our agency and/or services is required, particularly under Section B. Background Statement?
